COURSE OVERVIEW

The forklift license, Forklift truck (Class LF) has been classed as a high-risk license since 1 September 2010.

The course will provide learners with the skills and knowledge to undertake activities related to Forklift Operation. The course covers the operation of a powered industrial truck equipped with a mast and an elevating load carriage to which is attached a pair of fork arms or other attachments.

Training is conducted under the Work Health and Safety Regulations (SA) 2012 and Safe Work Australia's National Assessment Instruments for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work.

COURSE CONTENT

- Plan work
- Conduct routine checks
- Shift load
- Shut down and secure the forklift truck

COURSE DURATION

Delivered over 2 days, Face-to-Face.

COURSE OUTCOMES

This course will provide learners with the skills and knowledge to undertake activities related to Forklift Operation. ENTRY REQUIREMENT



- All learners must be 18 years or older for licensing requirements and will be required to provide photographic identification upon arriving for their course.
- Learners will need a level of language and literacy skills to meet the requirements of the course.

LEARNER REQUIREMENTS



- Have a valid Photo ID. (i.e. Australian Drivers Licence, Passport or Proof of Age Card). Mandatory for accredited courses.
- Must have a valid USI to be issued the Statement of Attainment.
